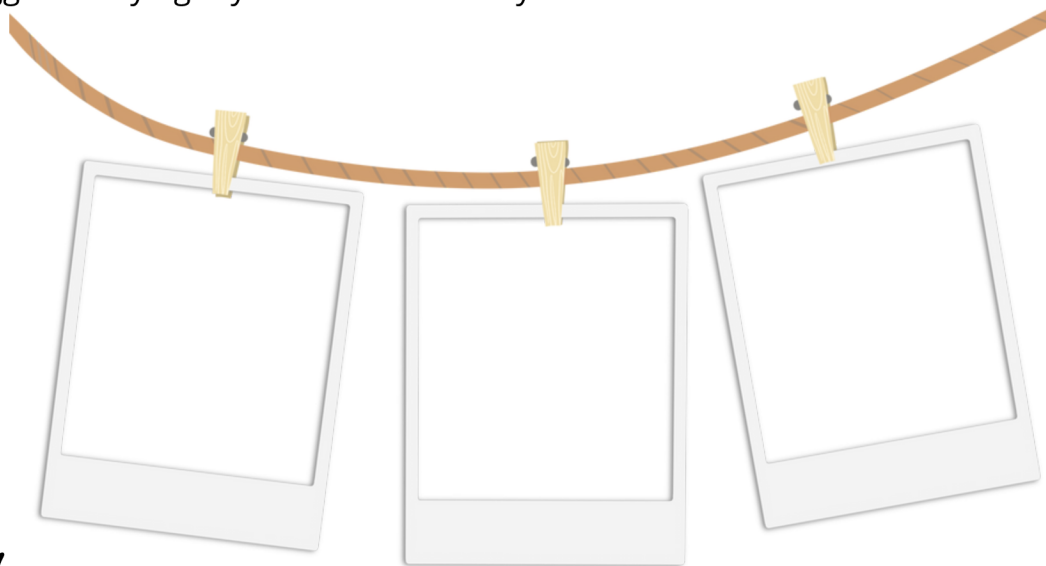
Charlie's Farewell Party
